Photo and Video Policy FAQ

Yes, please take photos and videos! The guidelines are below:

Can I record everything? What about workshop recaps?

You may record all of the competitions (including spotlight finals) and social dancing. Workshop recaps may only be recorded if allowed by the instructor.

Can I post my videos on YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, etc.?

For competition videos, yes, please do! We would all love it if you include hashtags #BridgeTownSwing #BridgeTownSwing20th in your description.

However, on behalf of our instructors, please do not post/share any workshop recaps — those recaps are only intended for the personal use of the students who took the workshop.

Can I walk onto the dance floor during competitions, or stand up front, or photo/video from the back of the dance floor, etc.?

No, you just have permission to photo/video from your seat, from someone else's seat, or from the edge of the floor on the <u>front or sides</u>. Only the official event photographer or videographer may capture the action from anywhere on the floor, including the back.

Will you have an event DVD or workshop notebook available?

We won't; instead we allow you to record all of the competitions and social dancing, plus workshop recaps instructor permitting.
